### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete and return **Application for Admission** form.
2. Attach a copy of applicant's last report card (not required for kindergarten.)
3. **Pay \$50.00 Application Fee (NON-REFUNDABLE)**
4. Present copy of applicant's birth certificate for age verification.
5. An admissions test will be scheduled for the applicant after requirements 1-4 above have been met.
6. Bring your child to the admission test.
7. Wait for notification that your child has been **ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION**.
